	CLASS "A"	License shall authorize retail sale on premises of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises or retail sale of unbroken packaged liquor for consumption off the premise.
	CLASS "B"	License shall authorize retail sale on premises, in unbroken packages, of alcoholic liquor for consumption off the premises.
	CLASS "C"	License shall authorize a caterer to serve alcoholic liquor as an incidental part of a food service that serves prepared meals which excludes the serving of snacks as a primary meal, either on or off-site.
	CLASS "D"	License shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption beyond the confines of the premises specified in the license but within the property lines of the property upon which the premises is located. <b>MUST</b> also hold an "A" license.
	CLASS "E"	License shall authorize retail sale on premises of alcoholic liquor for the consumption on the premises or retail sale of unbroken packaged liquor for consumption off the premise. Said Class E license to be in force for <b>150 consecutive days</b> , subject to time restrictions.
	CLASS "W"	A wine-maker's license shall authorize the manufacture of less than 50,000 gallons of wine, within the premises specified, and the storage and sale of such wine, per year to distributors in the state and persons outside the state.
