RFP 23-6116 Addendum 1 Zone Administration Services

Electronic Proposals due May 3, 2023, no later than 9:00 a.m. (CST)

Question 1:

What is the current status of the Woodstock/Harvard EZ regarding Marengo's formal inclusion & approval? And when approved, will the expansion change the way the zone must operate?

Response: The amendment to add Marengo to the Harvard/Woodstock Enterprise Zone, now McHenry County Enterprise Zone (Zone), has been approved. The Zone now has a seven member board of directors, instead of a five member board of directors with two representatives from each participating municipality and one representative for the County.

Question 2:

Any specific requirements around data/information storage?

Response: Data and information/records are backed up with the McHenry County Economic Development Corporation as shared. The Zone does have a hard drive for information storage.

Question 3:

Can we receive a copy of the 2023 full year budget and a 2023 YTD Budget update? Response: Yes, the information for the full year budget is attached. A 2023 YTD Budget update will be forthcoming. It is not available with posting of this Addendum. Are there any budget constraints or specific requirements? If so, what are they?

Question 4:

Response: None at this time.

Question 5:

Other than what is stated in the IL State EZ requirements for reporting and documentation, does McHenry County or Partner Municipalities have any additional requirements/documentation demands?

Response: The Administrator is required to provide regular reports to the board of directors. By practice, this has occurred every quarterly meeting of the board of directors.

Question 6:

How would you describe the existing relationships between the EZ and non-government actors (businesses & community organizations)?

Response: There does not appear to be much awareness of the Zone within the business and community organizations.

Question 7:

Are there any relationships that require immediate attention/focus? In what ways could they be stronger?

Response: The Zone does need a stronger relationship with the business community within the zone as many are unaware of the Zone's existence or the benefits it provides.

Question 8: What metrics does McHenry County deploy to evaluate the success of the EZ? Does

McHenry County set metrics & targets, or are they to be developed by the EZ

Administrator? Response: None.

Question 9: Does the EZ have a prescriptive operating procedure for engaging with local

businesses and community members to ensure local input is captured when making

decisions regarding the EZ?
