Need to register to vote or update your registration after moving or changing your name?

Grace Period Registration is now available at all early voting sites *(See page 2 for list.)*

To register to vote, you must be:

1. A U.S. Citizen.
2. At least 18 years of age by November 5th, 2024.
3. A resident of your precinct at least 30 days prior to election day.

In order to register, you must provide two forms of identification, one of which must include your current address. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- ★ Illinois driver's license/ ID Card
- ★ Social Security card
- ★ Valid U.S. Passport
- ★ Employee or student ID
- ★ Birth certificate
- ★ Public Aid ID Card
- ★ Credit Card
- ★ Utility bill in applicant's name
- ★ Lease or rental contract

Additionally, you may register to vote or update your registration and vote on Election Day at your correct polling place.
