- Styrofoam & packing peanuts
- Eyeglasses
- Alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt only)
- Rechargeable batteries (no more than 11 pounds)

Acceptable clean clothing (slightly stained or torn acceptable)
