After months of discussion, it was recommended for us to purchase an InRow Cooling System. It has been configured to handle the needs of the current and future equipment. Last October, the board approved \$5,000 for a solution that was not adequate to handle our needs. An additional \$5,000 is needed to complete this project correctly.
