FINANCIAL: The FY09-10 budget has been approved by the County Board, and goes into effect December 1, 2009. For 2010, the ETSB will be looking into having separate accounts and budgets for surcharge funds.

TECHNICAL: The In-Row Cooling System will be installed in the "server room" as soon as possible. Maintenance has been doing the prep work for the air ducts and electrical.

VisionAIR has been working with agencies capturing log files in an effort to determine why calls are not populating the dispatch screen in mobile. The calls are showing in Active Calls, which tells us the call is making it to the laptop.

PERSONNEL: Chief Rydberg requested the staff evaluations be completed as soon as possible.

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VISIONAIR APPLICATIONS-

- PSAP Administrators and Core Group Members met last month to discuss CAD issues, concerns, and other related topics. Please continue to forward information to the 911 office regarding issues.
- Please advise your TC's if they are coming across addresses that are not GEO-VALIDATING we need to know, and get them added to the system. We can't fix the issues if they are not being brought to our attention.
- The switch upgrade has been completed, and Ryan will be ready to distribute the new POLICE Mobile build on Friday the 20th.
- A police mobile focus group met last month as well to go over issues and concerns they are having. It was a
 productive meeting as officers worked together in providing information or shortcuts they have found. One
 example was not being able to run a CQH. This does work! An officer from an agency advised the others how
 to do it properly and get a valid return.
- The Fire Mobile Users also met to bring up issues and concerns. We will be meeting again at a later date.
- Reminder: VisionINFORM, to get call information, is available over the laptops for those who do not have a VPN
 or direct access to our network.

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PSAP/911-

Public Act 96-0788: The Illinois Premise Alert Program Act went into effect on August 28th, 2009. This allows families to voluntarily notify police and first responders about their special circumstances free of charge. This information must be maintained within a CAD system. I have samples of policies, and forms from various agencies. A policy and procedure needs to be put in place with how McHenry County agencies will be handling the receipt of such information. We then look for it to be sent to the ETSB office for entry.
