Conservation Revenue Impacts

- Conservation and rate interaction
 - Conservation Program + no water rate change
 - Water Rates = Conservation Program
 - Conservation Program + water rate change

- Conservation impacts capital investment timing
 - Decrease capital cost investment
 - What drives the peak?


