	C	SE 27	"Stewart House" Vander Karr Road  Historic landmark  Brick house with matching outhouse 1860-1875
Richmond	D	SE 31	"Mill Inn Tavern" Barnard Mill and Howe Road  Historic landmark  Formerly Barnard Mill - 1850
Burton	E	SW 18	"Richardson House" Richardson Road  Historic landmark  Stately home, still in the same family 1860's
Greenwood	F	SW 11	"Greenwood Town Hall" Greenwood Road  Historic landmark  Excellent example of frame town hall 1887
	G	NW 14	"Greenwood Cemetery" Greenwood Road  Historic landmark  Greenwood Civil War Memorial - unusual because it is made of cast iron - 1890
McHenry R-9	H	SE 6	"Johnsburg Chapel" Wilmot and Ringwood Road  Historic landmark  Built as a thanksgiving by the Muller family
Seneca	J	SW 23	"Seneca Town Hall" Franklinville Road  Historic landmark - 1870's - 1880's
	K	NW 30	Residence East side of Deerpass Road 1 mile north of Rt. 176  Historic Structure - c. 1840

Nunda R-8	N	SW 7	Residence East side of Cherry Valley Road between Crystal Springs Road and Mason Hill Road  Historic structure and landmark  House with rounded corners Victorian Italianate - 1865-72
	P	NW 7	Residence North side of Mason Hill Road at Cherry Valley Road  Historic structure and landmark  Colonial house. Has been in the Terwilliger family since it was built - 1849
	Q	NE 17	"Lovaas School" 6310 Crystal Springs Road at Walkup Avenue and Crystal Springs Road  Historic structure and landmark  Used to be Holcombville School - c. 1858
	R	SW 22	"T.C. Industries" Illinois 31, south of McHenry  Historic landmark  Used to be American Terra Cotta Corp., a major industry in the area - 1881 - 1967
	S	NE 32	Residence West of county highway 6, north of Carnella Drive  Historic structure
Coral	T	NW 6	Residence Southeast of Marengo on south side of U.S. 20  Historic structure and landmark  Anson Rogers House - 1840's
	U	NW 6	Residence Southeast of Marengo on south side of U.S. 20  Historic structure and landmark  East of Anson Rogers house; twin of Anson Rogers House

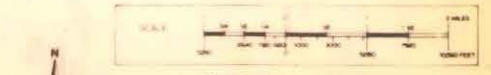
